Performer's Advantage will never disclose any personal information to a third party without verifiable consent in the form of a written letter. We regard your personal information as sensitive and private.

Performer's Advantage may share an individual's (including children under 13) personal information with a third party when necessary to:

- Assist with an investigation concerning public safety.
- Provide info to law enforcement personnel /comply with judicial process.
- Protect against liability.
- Ensure the availability, integrity and security of our website.

Children's Privacy Policy

The Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), passed in 1998, requires all web site operators whose audience includes children under the age of 13 to post a notice informing parents and legal guardians about how they collect, use and disclose personal information from children under 13 years of age. A verifiable consent must be obtained from parents or guardians in order for children under 13 years of age to use the Performer's Advantage website. The following policy details how Performer's Advantage is in compliance with COPPA:

We only collect personal information from individuals who have established a membership with Performer's Advantage (www.performersadvantage.com). The following information will be collected during sign up:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Gender
- Birth Date
- Email Address
- Username
- Password

If the birth date indicates that an individual is under age 13, the sign up process also asks for the email of the child's parent/guardian. This email will be used to contact the parent. The parent must agree to allow their child to obtain a membership before the child will be allowed to use the website. Once parental consent is obtained, we will only seek additional information which is deemed necessary for participation in a certain activity. We will not contact children under the age of 13 for any reason, without verifiable parental consent in the form of a written letter prior to contact. A child's information may be collected for child's participation in certain activities and interactive functions of Performer's advantage such as using message boards, engaging in instant message chatting, or sending email, etc
